## City of Wharton Preparation for Severe Weather

Wharton, TX, February 3, 2022-

The National Weather Service has announced that our region has a 30% chance of sleet starting at 6 p.m. this afternoon. Tonight, there is a chance of rain showers, freezing rain, and sleet before 3 a.m., and then a slight chance of freezing rain and sleet after 5 a.m. tomorrow. NWS is predicting Friday morning will be cloudy, with a low around 24 and wind chill values between 10 and 15 and little or no sleet accumulation expected.

With temperatures expected to drop below freezing, it is a good time to make sure People, Pets, Pipes and Plants are protected.

Additional Safeguards:

- Avoid going outside if it is not necessary. If you do, make sure you layer up from head to toe.
- Pets, like humans, are vulnerable to cold temperatures. If not taken care of properly, they can succumb to frostbite and even hypothermia.
- Make sure to cover all your exposed pipes with a cover. You can also cover your pipes with towels, duct tape or another adhesive strap, as long as they are wrapped tightly.
- When cold weather hits, it's a good idea to bring in all of your outdoor plants. If you can't bring in the plant, cover it with a blanket to make sure they do not die.

The City of Wharton will continue to monitor the weather for the safety of all citizens.
