

**CITY OF WHARTON  
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The City of Wharton, in its efforts to provide safer streets and eliminating traffic hazards, has adopted Chapter 70, Article I of the City of Wharton Code of Ordinances. The Ordinance sets requirements concerning hedges, shrubbery, trees or other obstructions hindering the view of automobiles or pedestrians or both.

The City of Wharton needs your assistance with trees located on private property. If they are overhanging onto the street, they should be trimmed to a height of fourteen (14) feet above the street. This will allow solid waste trucks to move safely and easily through City Streets.
