## Wharton County, TX, Saturday, August 1, 2020 1130 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **nineteen (19)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **12 (twelve)** new recoveries to report. There are **five (5)** probable cases included in these numbers.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **six hundred thirty-six (636)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred eighty-five (285)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred forty-four (344)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.
