Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **six (6)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **twenty-nine (29)** new recoveries to report. There are **three (3)** probable cases included in these numbers, bringing us to a total of **fifteen (15)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **six hundred sixty (660)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred twenty (320)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred twenty-nine (329)** active COVID-19 cases. **Four (4)** additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total is, sadly, **eleven (11)**.
