Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **fifty-eight (58)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **ninety-three (93)** recoveries and, sadly, **one (1)** more fatality. We are working on getting more information on deaths due to COVID in our County. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **15.4%**.
