Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **two (2)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **four (4)** new recoveries were reported, and one previous active case reported in Wharton County is now being reported in a neighboring county.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now **seventy-four (74)** in Wharton County and we have had **forty-two (42)** reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **thirty-one (31)** active COVID-19 cases.

Of the two new cases, we can share the following:

Gender	Age	City
F	20-30	Wharton
M	50-60	El Campo

The method of transmission in one of these cases is unknown, the other case is a family member.

We must remain diligent in our social-distancing and hygiene efforts. Now is not the time to let up on our social-distancing practices! Continue to avoid crowds, wear masks when it is required or you feel it is in your best interest to do so, and use good common sense when out in the community to avoid spreading disease.
