Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **NO (0)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **NO (0)** new recoveries to report. Here is the additional information on yesterday's cases. The two additions in El Campo were both males, one aged 20-30 and the other aged 50-60. The new case in East Bernard is a male 20-30 years old, and the Boling case is a male 40-50 years old.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now at **ninety-eight (98)** in Wharton County with **forty-four (44)** reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **fifty-three (53)** active COVID-19 cases.

This week Wharton County is having testing at 2 different locations.
