Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **six (6)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** recoveries to report. There are **two (2)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases remains at **fifty-seven (57)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand two hundred eighty-five (1,285)** in Wharton County and we have had **nine hundred six (906)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred fifty-one (351)** active COVID-19 cases. **No (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at **twenty-eight (28)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for today, Tuesday, September 8 at the Wharton Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
