**Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, December 16, 2020 1100 hours**

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred four (104)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **seventy-nine (79)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-three (63.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred six (206)**, that does NOT include any probables.

**IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next, Tuesday, DECEMBER 22, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is <https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening> The test is free. This may be the final opportunity for 2020.**
