**Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, December 23, 2020 1100 hours**

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **ninety-five (95)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **seventy-seven (77)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred sixty-five (265)**, that does NOT include any probables.

**IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, DECEMBER 29, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is <https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening> The test is free.**
