## Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, September 30, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **twelve (12)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **fifteen (15)** recoveries. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred fifty (1,450)** and we have had **one thousand three hundred forty-six (1,346)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **sixty-five (65)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, Octoer 6, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.
