Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-five (25)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **no (0)** recoveries. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities, thus our total number of COVID-19 confirmed deaths remains at **forty-nine (49)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **fifty-one (51)**, that does NOT include any probables.

**IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 6, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.**
