Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **four (4)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **one hundred seventy-seven (177)** recoveries to report. There are **no (0)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases remains at **fifty-five (55)**.

Because of an adjustment for a duplicate case, the total positive cases for COVID-19 is now one thousand two hundred sixty-five (1,265) in Wharton County and we have had six hundred thirty-three (633) reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has six hundred four (604) active COVID-19 cases. No (0) additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at twenty-eight (28).

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 8 at the Wharton Civic Center. No prior registration is required.
