Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **five (5)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **six (6)** recoveries to report. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred twenty-two (1,422)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred ninety (1,290)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **ninety-three (93)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: Our next county-wide testing will be Tuesday, September 29, at the Wharton Civic Center, from 8 am-4 pm. No prior registration is necessary.
