Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, July 29, 2020 1400 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **fifty-five (55)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **13 (thirteen)** new recoveries to report. There are **no (0)** probable cases included in these numbers.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **five hundred ninety-five (595)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred fifty-nine (259)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred twenty-nine (329)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.
