Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **no (0)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **four (4)** new recoveries to report.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now **two hundred twenty-three (223)** in Wharton County and we have had **seventy-six (76)** reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **one hundred forty-six (146)** active COVID-19 cases.

The recent upward trend in positive cases means we *must* remain diligent in our efforts to slow the spread of this disease. Now is not the time to let up on our social-distancing practices! **Take personal responsibility** and **do your part:** continue to avoid crowds, wear masks pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order and use good common sense when out in the community.
