Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **twenty (20)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **7 (seven)** new recoveries to report. There are **no (0)** probable cases included in these numbers.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **six hundred seventeen (617)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred seventy-three (273)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred thirty-seven (337)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.
