Wharton County, TX, Tuesday, August 25, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **forty-five (45)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **fifty-four (54)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand two hundred thirteen (1,213)** in Wharton County and we have had **four hundred forty-nine (449)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **seven hundred thirty-six (736)** active COVID-19 cases. **No (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at **twenty-eight (28)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing continues today, August 25, 8 am – 4 pm, at the Wharton Civic Center, 1924 N Fulton St. Register by calling 844-778-2455. Next scheduled testing is Tuesday, September 1 at the El Campo Civic Center.
