## Wharton County, TX, Friday, September 11, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **two (2)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **eighty-eight (88)** recoveries to report, with several adjustments. There is **one (1)** probable case included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases is **sixty (60)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand three hundred nineteen (1,319)** in Wharton County and we have had **one thousand one hundred sixty-one (1,161)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **one hundred nineteen (119)** active COVID-19 cases. Sadly, we have been notified of **eleven (11)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths is now **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 15 at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
