**Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, November 25, 2020 1000 hours**

Since Friday, Nov 20, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventy-seven (77)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **thirty-seven (37)** recoveries. We have also, sadly, received a report of **two (2)** more deaths, thus the number of fatalities is now **fifty-one (51.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **one-hundred twenty-three (123)**, that does NOT include any probables.

**IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, DECEMBER 1, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.**
