For the period of August 2-August 8, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred nine (109)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **17.53%**.
