For the one-week period of November 29 – December 4 , 2021, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventeen (17)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **3.31%**.

THIS IS THE LAST REPORT ON COVID-19 UNLESS A SURGE REQUIRES ADDITIONAL POSTINGS.

We continue to monitor the Omicron variant research and activity on a daily basis. The best defense available for the disease is still the vaccine and excellent hygiene efforts. If you have not been vaccinated, please consider getting that ASAP. If you are eligible for the booster, please get it ASAP. There is still plenty of vaccine available.
