For the period of October 25-31, 2021, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **eighteen (18)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **5.04%**.

Sadly, we report that since October 24 **one (1)** more of our residents have succumbed to this disease, bringing our total to **one hundred eighty-two (182)**.
