**For the period of November 1-7, 2021**, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-four (34)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **3.75%**.

Sadly, we report that since October 31, **two (2)** more of our residents have succumbed to this disease, bringing our total to **one hundred eighty-four (184)**.
