Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **four (4)** new positive case of COVID-19 and **NO (0)** new recoveries were reported.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now **seventy-three** (73) in Wharton County and we have had **thirty-eight** (38) reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **thirty** (34) active COVID-19 cases.

Of the four new cases, we can share the following:
