Wharton County, TX, Thursday, September 10, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **sixteen (16)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **fifty-eight (58)** recoveries to report. There are **two (2)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases is **fifty-nine (59)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand three hundred seventeen (1,317)** in Wharton County and we have had **one thousand seventy-nine (1,079)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **two hundred ten (210)** active COVID-19 cases. **No (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at **twenty-eight (28)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 15 at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
