Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred seven (107)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **ninety-eight (98)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **21.01%**.
