Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **twenty-seven (27)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **eight (8)** new recoveries to report. There are **three (3)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **eighteen (18)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **seven hundred nine (709)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred thirty-four (334)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred sixty-four (364)** active COVID-19 cases. The number of deaths remains at **eleven (11)**.
