Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **one hundred twelve (112)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** new recoveries to report. There are **eight (8)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **thirty (30)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **eight hundred forty-six (846)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred fifty (350)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **four hundred eighty-five (385)** active COVID-19 cases. The number of deaths remains at **eleven (11)**.
